

Akkar is now introducing a .410 calibre to its unique Triple Crown range of shotguns

Eye-catching Akkar

Turkish gunmaker Akkar has announced a .410 model adding to their Triple Crown range of shotguns. These eye-catching guns use a pyramidal barreled design, with three 28" tubes arranged two side-by-side and one on the top, making it very easy to shoot. The fibre-optic sight and 7mm top-rib offers a good sight picture. The mechanism employs a single mechanically-operated trigger and fires - left, right then top. Barrels are Remington threaded and come with a

set of five chokes (F, IM, M, IC & C). The action is extract-only and uses a manual safety and weighs just 3.3kg thanks to its reduced receiver height and shorter frame than a traditional double barreled gun. The stock is made from oil-finished walnut with chequering on the pistol grip, which complements the smart matte blued barrels. The steel receiver is tough and durable, RRP is £1,999.99
